

Sultan of Perak has crest for his exclusive use 0044

THE Sultan of Perak has a royal crest for his exclusive use. The crest, redesigned last year, is shown above.

The Jawi inscription reads: "Allah protect the Sultan of Perak."

The Perak royal coat of arms (right) was also redesigned last year.

It is for the use of the Raja Perempuan, the Raja Muda and the Raja di-Hilir.

In both the royal crest and coat of arms is the State sword, to represent authority.

Reminders

The hill and sea in a corner of the coat of arms are reminders of the origin of the Perak sultanate—the first of the royal line came to the State by crossing the sea from Bukit Siguntang in Sumatra.

Apart from these two royal emblems, Perak also has a State crest, which can be seen on official letterheads and documents.

This has not been redesigned.
